## White Fleet

### Notice regarding Lost Race Days 1, 4 and 6.

Unfortunately, due to difficult weather, we are exactly half way through the series, and we have already lost half the scheduled race days due to either too much or too little wind.

The Race Committee will continue to attempt to run 3 races for all white fleet classes on each of the remaining Race Days.

We believe that no changes to Sailing Instructions are required to achieve this.

## Black Fleet

### Notice regarding Lost Race Days 1 (7<sup>th</sup> Oct) and 6 (18<sup>th</sup> November)

The IRC Classes 0, 1 and 2 are short 1 race on the Series. The IRC Class 3 and 4 and the J109 and J105 classes are 2 races short.

The Race Committee intention is to run 2 races for entire Black Fleet on 25<sup>th</sup> November. The first start of the day will be at 10:00. After finishing that race competitors should listen to "Hamble Comms" for the location of the 2<sup>nd</sup> start of the day.

All classes will have tight time limits on 25<sup>th</sup> November only.

## Amendment No. 6 to Black Fleet Sailing Instructions

The following amendments apply to races sailed on 25<sup>th</sup> November only.

### 1.4 Class Flags (and Start Sequence order) & 5.2 Start Order

Classes will start as signaled, and may not be in the specific order shown in SI 1.4.

### 9.1 Time limit

The following time limits will apply.

The time limit for a boat will be 20 (corrected) mins after the first boat in her class finishes. Boats not finishing within the time limit will be scored the average of the points available to those boats in her class still racing had such boats finished. This changes RRS A4.2.

A boat may without infringing RRS 41 (Outside help) request and receive details of leaders finish times. This changes RRS 35 & RRS 41.
